Summary of Project Report: for 2022-23

Air pollution control is difficult, since air is more diffusive and disperses more in space. Therefore, any control technology for air pollutants will be more effective at the source, rather than after dispersion into environment. However less research has been carried out on the emission of suspended particulate matter and reparable particulate matter, assessment with respect to human health problem. Hence it is decided carry out the assessment of air quality with respect to suspended particulate matter and reparable particulate matter, in one of the thickly populated areas of cluster of industries at Vidarbha region. Due to large-scale vehicular traffic and industrial activities, it has recently attracted public attention due to increasing population of environment in the area. In this study, an attempt has been made to carry out the ambient air quality monitoring of industrial zone, for determining the likely sources of pollution and subsequently finding the ways for eradicating them.

Air monitoring is usually the long term, systematic and routine measurement of air pollution that may be carried out for disperse purposes. The sampling sites together with equipment in acquiring and analyzing the data constitute the monitoring network. The monitoring of air may be carried out broadly for the purpose of impact assessment, surveillance and management process. Air quality monitoring is used to determine quantity, type of pollutant emission as well as any effects of such emissions on public health and the environment. Meaningful air quality monitoring requires understanding of the significance of various parameters as indicators of quality, plus baseline data for the area under consideration and criterion for acceptable ambient concentration of pollutants.

The adverse effects of various atmospheric pollutants on human, animal and plant life along with our climate are the major concerns of environment protection agencies all over the globe, with India being no exception. The atmospheric pollution is injurious to human health, plants and animals. In brief, it may be described as the imbalance in quality of air, which causes adverse effects on the living organisms that exist on the earth. Air is seldom found clean in nature and air pollutants cause damage to target or receptor. The target may be man, animal, plant, building or materials which are adversely affected by these pollutants. The major sources of air pollution are both natural and manmade viz volcanic eruptions, radioactive emission from minerals, forest fires, dust and aerosols of natural and manmade origin. The boom in population, deforestation, industrialization, burning of fossils fuels and mining activities etc. to support our present-day life style is further adding to the pollution. Further, these pollutants hardly exist beyond 2000 feet above ground level and their concentration is sufficient to disturb the dynamic equilibrium in the atmosphere thereby affecting the man and his environment. The first step is to determine and averaging times for which there are significant areas. Cumulative assessment is carried out for the pollutants and averaging times for which the source under consideration has impacts above existing levels that prevent significant Dr.K.Gajanan 3.10.23 deterioration.

b. The sanction is issued in exercise of the powers delegated to the council and other terms & conditions laid down in the guidelines of the scheme.




